HISTORY

As the history begins, Malaya was once a Sitio of Barangay Quinabigan, it was formerly named Sitio Malabo by the Early settlers, which was officially given in a consecrated mass by a Pinamalayan Priest who officiated a mass on their nipa church during that time. It was on the Mr. Jose Jamilla, that one of the councilors of Marcus Fortus suggested the name MALAYA, it was adopted from PI/NA/MALAYA/N. They also suggested of Malaya from Quinabigan and made her an independent Barangay. The name Malaya was officially declared in a consecrated mass held at the Barangay Church, officiated by then by the Pinamalayan Parish Priest Fr. Benito Rexner.

Though it was a sitio, Malaya has their own set of Barangay Officials, Its first Barangay Lieutenant was Mr. Antonio Palustre, and he was succeeded by Martin Constantino and followed by Mr. Pedro Selda. It was on the time of Mr. Selda that a school made of nipa was constructed. Mr. Leon Motol succeeded Mr. Selda and he continued the construction of the nipa school building. 1950-1953, Mr. Frisco Abuel was elected Brgy. Lieutenant through raising of hands by the electorate Genero Mercene.

During his second term, school building has been constructed through the aid of Congressman Peping Morente and assistance of Mayor Manoling Morente.

The third Councilman of Mr. Jose Jamilla were as follows, Cornelio Nazareno, Bonifacio Sapusao, Romeo Faildo, Angelita Jamilla, Vicente de los Reyes and Romeo Caluyo. Their project include Construction of Basketball Court, Construction of old Barangay hall and DPWH deep well at Sitio Centro. Barangay Captain Jose Jamilla served the Barangay for almost twenty nine years (29).

In the Barangay election in 1991, he ran again for barangay Captain but unfortunately he lost by his councilman Romeo Faildo. Barangay Captain Romeo Faildo's councilman were as follows, Teofilo P. Sapusao, Alfredo Jamilla, Bernardino Lorinio, Cipriano Padilla, Felix Mercene, Marlon Madronial and Pedrito Magtahao.

Their first project include, Construction of Barangay Waiting Shed, Construction of Barangay Health Center, Construction of Mini-Dam in Balaas, also during their term upland portion also sub-divided into 39 beneficiaries. He also help in the opening of Balaas and temporarily sub-divided into his constituents.

On his second term as Barangay Captain, his councilors were Cipriano Padilla, Felix Mercene, Emelita Faildo, Crispin Constantino, Pedrito Magtahao, Geronimo Rodas and Artemio Mangubat. Their project include continues work in Balaas project, rehabilitation of Barangay Day Care Center, Construction of AC/BS Station, Barangay Tanod Outpost and Construction of School Building.

Barangay Captain Romeo Faildo, were extended for another 3 years due to the postponement of barangay election of May 1996. For this three years, one of their major accomplishment was the subdivision of 40 hectares land under CARP Program to the 40 lucky beneficiaries of the Barangay.

In the Barangay election of 1999 he was defeated by his councilor Teofilo P. Sapuso, who succeeded him. Barangay Captain Teofilo Sapuso's first term councilors were Pedrito Magtahao, Artemio Mangubat, Cipriano Padilla, Emelita Faildo, Geronimo Rodas, Pacifico Delmo and Patricio Jamilla Sr. Their projects were barangay market at Sitio Centro, Multi Purpose hall from the aid of Cong. Punzalan, a concrete roadway at Sitio Bagong Sikat, Solar Dryer and a Basketball Court. Mini park was an SK project by SK Chairwoman Resflor Sadicon.

On Barangay Captain Teofilo Sapuso's second term his Councilors were Pedrito Magtahao, Emelita Faildo, Pacifico Delmo, Geronimo Rodas, Resflor Sadicon, Artemio Mangubat and Anthony Fabello. Their projects include Concrete Road Continuation that comprises almost from Sitio Bagong Sikat, Sitio Centro a concrete fence of the Barangay Lot.

Elected Councilor Anthony Fabello filed a resignation before the DILG MLGOO Jeanette Mingi for some personal reasons. But despite of that the Sanggunian continued their own sworn service to the barangay.

On the third year of Teofilo Sapuso's term it was 2006 again a former SK-Resflor Sadicon that was then a Kagawad took her choice to practice her teaching profession and leave the Sangguniang Barangay. She was replaced by a former Kagawad Patricio Jamilla Sr. that was placed (8) eighth at the 2004 election by the powerful authority of the Barangay captain and by the approval of DILG MLGOO.

Year 2006, was the time for the Sanggunian to begin, then the joint effort of both SK and SB computer set was purchased, also the SK Hall building (not completed) other were grilling and renovation of Barangay Hall Main Building, Barangay Road Opening at Sitio Mahabang Parang and the deep well repair at the Sitio Centro.

Continuation and repair of concrete farm to market road wasn't able to implement due to the gravel shortage but it was the year 2007's priority for the first quarter. Resolution made for the talipapa making asking for financial support from the municipal and provincial offices. Funds for the opening of canal system of the low land proposed ricefield that will support the mission of Pinamalayan to produce more food for the province and the rest of MIMAROPA was already requested from the D.A other concern office.

In the Barangay Election of 2007 Capt. Teofilo Sapuso was defeated by Romeo Faildo who was his opponent in the past year of election.

Barangay Captain Romeo Faildo's term councilors were Crispin Constantino, Gilbert Faildo, Marcelina Jamilla, Abel Morales, Anthony Fabello, Pacifico Delmo and Patricio Jamilla Sr.

On their first term of service the Renovation of Barangay Hall at Sitio Centro. Year 2009 their project included road reconstruction of Sitio Bagong Sikat, Construction of Stage inside the barangay lot and the Installation of Street light at Sitio Centro by the elected SK-Chairman Gerald Caluyo.

Before the 2010 Barangay Election they continue their project like continuing the street lights at Sitio Pag-asa, and last they continue Road Concreting at Sitio Farmers Village.

On Barangay Captain Teofilo Sapusao's second term his Councilors were Abel Morales, Juan Jamilla Jr., Marcelina P. Jamilla, Anthony Fabello, Gilbert Faildo, Rosauro Sajo and Pedrito Magtahao, Year 2015 from 20% Development Fund their project includes Slope Protection to Sitio Bagong Sikat, and Road Concreting of Sitio Mahabang Parang, is one of the Priority Project including Installation of Solar Streets light from Sitio Green Hills to Sitio Farmers Village and Installation of Barangay Water System.

Year 2016 Barangay Captain Teofilo P. Sapusao, one of their major accomplishment and Priority Project was Installation of Streets Light, road concreting of Sitio Mahabang Parang, and farm to market road concreting project by Kalahi-CIDDS at Sitio Mahabang Parang. Construction of Barangay Water System the Salin Tubig Project by DILG Mar Roxas year 2017.

Year 2018, Barangay election was held. At this time the incumbent Punong Barangay, has retained as Barangay Captain because he has no opponent. The new set of Sanggunian were Gilbert L. Faildo, Reynilo S. Sadicon, Robert N. Lorinio, Perry S. Browit, Juan J. Jamilla Jr., Elizabeth Edna J. Mangubat and Marcelyn D. Faildo.

And this year, also they back the Sangguniang Kabataan (SK) again that lately was called TASK FORCE. That's why they conduct the SK election. Rea Joy M. Jamilla ran as SK Chairwoman. Because she doesn't have opponent. She declared as SK Chairwoman 2018 of Barangay Malaya.

The challenge was there and will be there but the Sangguniang Barangay of Malaya will continue forcing it strongly for the betterment of its future.

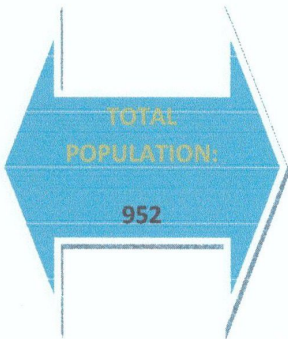
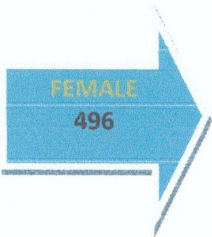
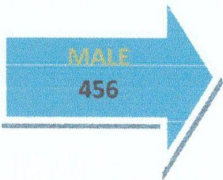
